Winter Recipe

■ Hot Mulled Wine Recipe:

2 btls J. Lohr Estates Wildflower Valdiguié

4 tablespoons lemon juice

1/2 teaspoon nutmeg

3 cinnamon sticks

15 whole cloves

1/2 cup sugar

Combine first 5 ingredients and bring to a boil. Add the sugar and stir until dissolved. Reduce heat to low and simmer for 30 minutes. Serve warm. 12 - 4oz servings.
